- a) Four Special Tests were conducted during the year 2017-18 in four spells.
- b) Two grand tests were conducted during 2018-19.
- c) One pre-final was conducted.
- d) The syllabus was completed by 15th November 2017.
- e) Daily one hour special classes have been conducted one hour in the morning session and one hour after school hours to have a special focus on the C grade children and above average children.
- f) Remedial classes have been conducted to the below average students.
- g) Adoption of below average children by the subject teacher.
- h) Counseling to the parents of the below average students to send their children regularly to the school and to pay proper attention at home also.
